13.1 New Course Update - M. Carruth / Karlie Sherwood

Karlie Sherwood will be presenting details on the new HS Broadcast Journalism class offered this year from the 1st semester. Ms. Sherwood spoke about the class description and objectives. She outlined the skills such as researching, writing to inform, command of language, media literacy. She played a few samples of students podcasts. Two

students were present to give testimonials regarding their experience in the Broadcast Journalism class.

13.2 Suicide Coalition Presentation – J. Zewatsky (13)

Venessa Zverotic introduced Mr. Brian Galdes from the Suicide Prevention Coalition of Livonia. Mr. Galdes presented an introduction and overview of the coalition. The Coalition is made up of 9 different school districts. His group seeks to address youth suicide prevention, support mental health and in turn aim for zero completed youth suicides in Western Wayne School Districts served. The Coalition has helped train over 3,000 school staff members in seven school districts in the last year.

13.3 SAEBRS / mySAEBRS – M. Carruth / J. Zewatsky (14-26)

Ms. Carruth and Mr. Zewatsky shared the Fall and Winter Testing Window for Grades K-12. The data was broken out by building and by grade level K-12. Mr. Zewatsky outlined how they use the data and programs that are driven from the data to work with students directly as well as with parents and planning for district-wide wellness nights.

Mr. Bergeron is recommending to the Board the purchase of Vape Detectors for five sets of rest rooms at the high school and 2 sets at the middle school installed by PCS utilizing OMNIA Partners Co-Op bid for the purchase and installation of a total of 14 HALO Vape Sensors to be installed at the High School and Middle School.
