- President Myers visited all buildings before holiday break. Attended Band / Choir Concert. Thanked the LSO for their donations of the Timpani's.

- **16.4** Learning Services M. Carruth gave the board a quick update about the SABERS/MYSABERS screener. She will report out to the education committee.
- **16.5** Student / Special Services J. Zewatsky reported to the board that NARCAN is now in each building with a backup pen available. Staff has been trained.

Mr. Zewatsky also reported 1,000 Covid tests are being provided to the district to be able to distribute to the students and the community as requested and needed.

# 17. <u>Superintendent Items</u>

- 17.1 School Index Scorecard M. Carruth gave a Mid-Year update from the Curriculum and Instruction Department. She provided the Board with updates from the Michigan School Index System showing federally-required school accountability measures for each building. Mrs. Carruth highlighted some of the scores earned at each building level for; Overall Index, Growth Index, Proficiency Index, Student Quality and Student Success Index and Graduation Rate Index.
  - Mrs. Carruth also detailed the implementation of the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester after-school tutoring program. Grandview 8 week sessions-3 days a week one hour, Botsford 8 week sessions-2 days a week one hour, MS 8 week sessions-3 days a week, one hour
  - There are staffing changes happening to provide more intensive supports at the secondary level. We are adding additional interventionists at the Middle School level in reading and math and the High School level in Math. The positions are grant funded.
  - There is a new retired teacher program implemented at the elementary level. 8 teachers are coming back to tutor high risk elementary students during the day. They will be onsite 5 hours a day to providing tutoring for some individual and small group sessions.
  - New furniture update. New Furniture has been delivered and installed at Grandview. High School is coming next, followed by Middle School and

finally Botsford. The pilot classrooms have been painted. Once all of the furniture has been received for a building, it will be installed.
