Shepich / Randy Liepa** presented the formal recommendations from the research conducted across all stakeholders throughout the District and surrounding Community for facility configurations. He presented 3 options to the Board for future implementation after more planning and discussions.
 - 1. Close one school –and have configurations PK-5, 6-8, 9-12 ask for Bond to improve the schools and look at expanded Pre-K program to attract new families.
 - Close one school and have configurations PK-4, 5-8, 9-12, ask for Bond to improve the schools and look at expanded Pre-K program to attract new families. This allows for a smaller elementary facility, which will be large under PK-5 and the feedback was somewhat close to option 1.
 - 3. Leave schools as they are today, still look for possible bond issue to improve the schools, limited renovations and spread out over more facilities, expand Pre-K program.
