

F.O.G. Meeting Minutes

December 15, 2020 • 6pm • Via Zoom

- **Opening:** Nick Dorst
 - Meeting started right at 6- some parents trickled in a few minutes late
 - All FOG Board members are present
 - FOG is still in need of a President and Co-Vice President
- **Teacher's Report:** Mr. Matt Mair, P.E. Teacher
 - Mrs. Carruth presented the presentation that Mr. Mair created for the School Board meeting about how he has been involved in INPACT: Interrupting Prolonged Sitting with Activity
 - INPACT has been developed by the U of M School of Kinesiology
 - It is an evidence-based study showing the benefits of getting kids up and moving during this age of virtual learning and sitting in front of a computer for long periods of time
 - The activities are home-based and enables Michigan's K-12 students access to activities based on their age-range/developmental skills
 - Mr. Mair has created 10 videos for Detroit Public Television
- **Principal's Report:** Mrs. Carruth
 - Mrs. Carruth spent lots of time explaining the new parent survey that was sent out to parents about the choices for students for the 2nd semester.

 - Mrs. Carruth mentioned that if your
circumstances change at any point
after completing the survey, please call

- This survey is for preparation purposes ONLY
 - There is still no date for the school opening
for in-person learning
- It is a semester commitment, just like the survey
before school began
- You can change your choice from what is
currently is (i.e. If your student is in Virtual
Academy, you can now place them in Option 1,
Hybrid-Remote)
- Hybrid-Remote students will go to in-person
learning based off of whichever model the
School Board approves and WHEN they vote that
it is safe to return to in-person learning
 - Hybrid-Remote students will go 2 days a
week, either Monday and Tuesday or
Thursday and Friday from 9:30-3:00
 - The kids that are not at school on the day
will have morning check-ins from 9-9:30
and 3:10-3:50
- Specials Teachers will be available for support
during in-person hours for kids that are at home
- Wednesdays will be a complete virtual day for all

- Small Group times
- Asynchronous afternoons for teacher planning and meetings, etc.
- Special Education students will go 4 days/week
 - 2 days with their class and 2 days with their support teachers
- GSRP will follow whatever the Elementary model is
- Latch Key will be available based on interest and if staffing needs can be met
- Classrooms are cohorted
 - Plastic shields around desks to encourage distancing while travelling throughout the classrooms
 - Manipulatives and supplies will not be shared; there will be some for each student
 - Chromebooks will not be going back and forth from home to school; in-person learning will not be using them while at school
 - Mrs. Carruth made the point that Elementary students will not be travelling outside of the classrooms so anything COVID related will be easier contained
